



"Sheldon L. Wight, His Story, Including His Civil War Diary---1865, Pvt. Co. F, 6th Michigan Cavalry," ending the war at Appomattox and going on with the Powder River Expedition into Wyoming Territory.

The research is finished and the book is published about Leonard Wight's family who moved to Eaton County, Michigan from Lorain County, Ohio in about 1858. I have included some information about all his children Lydia, Francis B., Sheldon L., Alexander Mason, Reuben William and Abraham Lincoln Wight.

Included is the story of Sheldon Wight's life, and his diary from 1865 when he was in the 6th Michigan Cavalry Regiment in the Civil War. He writes of the raids in the Shenandoah Valley, and being at Appomattox when the treaty was signed. The part of the diary of special interest to Civil War historians is his daily account of being sent west at the end of the war from Washington D.C. to take part in the Powder River Expedition in Wyoming Territory. There a group of soldiers from the 6th Michigan built Fort Connor on the Powder River, and he was one of them. His records from the National Archives are included.

This Expedition isn't extensively documented so the Wight diary adds a bit to the history of the 6th Michigan Cavalry. His description of just getting to the Powder River is very interesting. It took about two months by rail, boat travel and horseback to get there.

The book covers Sheldon's family history from his birth in Ohio to his "running away" to the Civil War. After his return in 1866 to Benton Township he married Mary Ann Weaver and they migrated to Gratiot County Michigan as pioneers. His story continues until his death in 1919 in Elsie, Michigan. His photographs remain as a legacy for he became known as "the photographer of Elsie and the surrounding area." They moved to Elsie, Clinton County about 1904 from the village of Sickels, which he had platted with William Sickels in 1882. Records of this plat are included.

There are two taped interviews done years ago with his grandchildren, Vern Wight (my Dad) and Wilma Mitchell Wirebaugh, which have been transcribed and included in the story.

If you are interested in a copy of the book let me know. It has a hard cover, over 40 photographs, (most of them S. Wight originals), 2 color pictures, indexed, on glossy paper and very carefully researched. I started working on this in 1961. There are 238 pages. Vital records and land records are included plus newspaper research from 1860 to 1866.

It is a limited edition so its cost is \$45.00 with \$4.00 added for mailing. 250 copies printed.

History of Lee Township

Below is a synopsis of the Lee Township history as found in the <u>1877 History of Calhoun County</u>. Originally published in 1877, the Calhoun County Genealogical Society had the History republished in March of 1998. See page 2 of this newsletter for information on how to order a copy.

In the spring of 1835 Amos HADDEN and Nicholas STANLEY entered and occupied a part of section 36, in the southeast part of the town. The former yet resides on the old place. His neighbor, Mr. STANLEY, lost his life in the caving in of a well in which he was at work. In 1837 a child of Mr. STANLEY became lost in the woods and created an excitement not soon forgotten. One evening Mr. STANLEY, hearing the tinkle of the cow-bell a short distance from the house, started his son, a child of six years, into the woods to drive the cows home. The cows soon came in, but the boy was not with them, and repeated calls brought no reply. Immediate search was instituted and fruitlessly maintained for three days. The neighbors, turning out, scoured the country for an area of ten miles. The child was found at last, distant from home but a short half mile. He sat at the foot of a tree with his back leaning against it, and was dead. He had perished from cold and hunger. The Rev. Mr. Hobert officiated at his funeral, at which were held the first religious services in the town.

In 1836, Abram HADDEN, a brother of Amos, took up his residence in the vicinity, and simultaneously, several of his old neighbors from New York settled in Clarence, Sheridan, and Marengo, thereby forming what has since been known as the "Rice Creek Settlement." Benjamin THOMAS, a settler of 1836, in Marengo, from Sardinia, Erie county, New York, removed in 1839 to a farm situated in the central northern part of the township. B. S. WARD settled near the Eaton line, in the northern part of the town, and lives there at this time. In 1840, D. P. WOOD, for one or two years a resident of Albion, desirous to improve his condition, set out for Clarence, and made his way around Duck lake into Lee. A log hut was built, and unchinked, occupied till fall. It was his home for two years. In August, 1840, some land cleared was in crop, when Mr. WOOD was married to Maria PAYNE, of Jackson County.

Among those of other early settlers we find the names of Stephen ALDRICH, F. GARFIELD, John WEAVER, T.S. HAVENS, Charles R. THOMAS and Jesse ACKLEY. Early in 1836 Sidney S. ALCOTT located the major portions of sections 6 and 7. During the year following he built a saw-mill on a branch of Indian creek – a small creek running through the northwest part of the township. The mill was operated for several years by F. GARFIELD, but being burned was never replaced. It was the only water-power saw-mill built in the township.

A stock company was formed in 1844 by G. W. DRYER and others, and known as the "Dover Company." They purchased a large body of land in the vicinity of what is now called Partello Post-Office, and began the erection of a mill, which they failed to complete. In time the property was purchased by J. R. PARTELLO and a saw-mill erected. The first white child [born in] Lee was James, son of Nicholas STANLEY, born July 31, 1836. The first female child was Dorcas J. HADDEN, daughter of Amos Hadden, born October 4, 1838.

On the following page is the continuation of the story we published on pages 6 and 7 of the August/September 1998 edition of <u>Generations</u>. The story gives an account of a trip taken by CCGS member Elma Carpenter, her sister Virgene Franks, and their cousin Nancy Bard to their ancestor's homeland in the Czech Republic. What a thrill to be able to walk the soil of an ancestor, particularly in their native land! Following the summary of the story is a descendancy chart for their ancestor Josef Bures.

CONTINUATION, THE JOSEF BURES FAMILY OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Next we went to Lestina where John Vaclav Bures, oldest child of Josef and Anna Franek Bures was born. We stopped at the town hall, and the clerk there showed us where house No. 50 was located. It is occupied by a Jaroslav Bures, son of Frantisek and grandson of Josef. He could not remember his grandmother's name. The town clerk said Jaroslav is not married. She had previously told Marie in a phone call that Jaroslav Bures was "strange." We knocked on the door of the house and Marie visited with Jaroslav. Other than his father's name and his grandfather's name, he did not have any information.

We walked back down the hill towards the town hall. On the way Nancy took a picture of an old wooden pump and trough. The town clerk said that was were the women in the village used to do laundry. When we arrived back at the town hall the clerk looked up the name of the owner of house No. 10. House No. 10 is the former home of Anna Kulhavy who married Josef Bures, who were the parents of Josef Bures who married Anna Franck. The house is still owned by the Kulhavy family and is used as a weekend home. There is a fruit cellar in the side of the hill. Again more pictures were taken. They keep a lovely garden there. The town clerk said the owners live in Vysoke Myto. There are 150 permanent residents in Lestina. The lady in the town office also keeps land records for four other villages - a total of 350 records. Maria told us the vital records for all of the villages were kept in Prosec. The town clerk also said there was a pipe factory in Prosec.

On to Prosec and the pipe factory. We bought pipes as souvenirs because they were made in the area where our ancestors lived. A lady working there also gave us several pipes that did not pass inspection, and told Marie to hide them while another man was in the office making out paper work for the pipes we were buying. Then on to the town hall. The clerk was not there. She was across the street at the museum with a Czech TV crew that was filming. We went to the local Pub for lunch (3:30 p.m.) When she was through at the museum the town clerk came to get us. We went to her office. She had the original birth, marriage and death indexes. The records themselves are now in the archives in Zamrsku. She also had borrowed the church records from the priest at the church in Nove Hrady. They are records which begin in 1630. There are several references to when the church was renovated. When the graves were causing the side wall and roof to collapse, the roof was replaced with a tin roof and steel rods were anchored to the outside walls to pull the walls together.

The town clerk of Prosec checked her records and told us Josef Bures died 16 Feb 1902 at the age of 77, which means he was born in 1831. His wife, Anna Kulhavy, died 31 July 1875.

Josef married again to Magdalene (whose maiden name was Severova), from the village of Makov, house No. 33, widow of Vaclav Bartak from Libecina. Magdalene was born 2 Jan 1838 and died 15 Sep 1908. She and Josef had two children:

- 1. Anna who died 21 June 1913 at age 16
- 2. Vaclav who died 24 Nov 1913 at age 11

The marriage records showed that Josef Bures, son of Josef Bures and Anna Kulhavy, was married 23 Feb 1886 to Anna Franck in the church at Nove Hrady.
