KENNETH AND SHIRLEY STONE TRANSCRIBE THE FIVE CEMETERIES, CLARENCE TWP.

CALHOUN COUNTY, MICHIGAN

A major contribution to the C.C.G.S. cemetery transcription project has been completed by Kenneth and Shirley Stone, 22150 27½ Mile Road, Springport MI, 49284. These two have re-walked cemeteries and rechecked their records three times--- a great effort to make sure of accuracy and completeness.

They have included the following in their work;

- 1. A map of Clarence Twp. showing the location of it's five cemeteries. The names and numbers listed are coordinated with the Michigan Cemetery Atlas, Library of Michigan, 1991. Clarence Center (#27), Nichols (#50 Clarence Dist. #4), Dyer (#60- Clarence on the Hill), Krenerick (#59), and Hunt (#26 North Clarence).
- 2. A map of Clarence Center Cemetery.
- 3. 4x6 cards containing(in some cases)the following information are filed: a. Name and dates of the deceased. b. Organizations belonged to- such as Masons, VFW etc. c. Location of the grave.
- d. Spouse and the date of marriage. e. Cause of death and age.
- f. Name of parents.(All of Clarence Center Cemetery.)
- 4. Nichols, Dyer, Krenerick, and Hunt cemeteries have been transcribed with the same information on 4x6 cards as above.
- 5. There is a list of original owners of lots in Hunt Cemetery- with a map of Hunt Cemetery.
- 6. Deaths which occured in Clarence Twp. but deceased were buried elsewhere. (1930-1940 only)

The Stones have included in their Clarence Twp. research the U.S. Census records for 1840, 1850, and 1860. Kenny said "the 1870 census was too big" with the settlement of Clarence expanding so fast. These were done from microfilm records. Other sources of information were the burial records found in the Clarence Twp. Hall which Kenny said were far from complete. Marriage, death records were searched for at the Calhoun Co, Clerks Office. Each cemetery was transcribed for tombstone readings also.

This work is complete to September of 1992, and a tremendous boost to the preservation of Calhoun County records. The material is presently housed in the C,C,G,S. archives at the Local History Room, Albion. The next step will be to put this material on computer for publication by the society.



Where To Find Civil War Sources

The Burton Historical Collection

"The Burton Collection's holdings for Civil War records are very good for the northern states but sparse for the southern states. Virtually all the states that fought on the northern side have published lists of men who fought in the volunteer regiments from their state. Occasionally, the service record may be included stating whether the man was wounded or died in service. Unfortunately, most of these state lists have no indexes so researchers have to look for their ancestors name by name.

The reason the Burton Collection has very few of the lists of men who served in the Confederate Army is that very few have been published. North Carolina is publishing a list of its men who fought for the Confederacy, but is it one of the few southern states to do that. The best place to find listings of Confederate soldiers is the Burton Collection's Military Service Lists Catalog (No. 13).

Michigan's list of Civil War soldiers, Record of Service of Michigan Volunteers in the Civil War. 1861-1865. Is one of the most complete of all the states. The forty-six volume set includes one volume on each regiment. Each volume is arranged alphabetically. For each individual the service record, enlistment, and discharge dates are given. There is one index for the entire set."


